NSP Course # P05.....

We will review the Senior Program in depth, review the updated PNWD Senior Manual and go over the global paperwork for registering and closing courses. The course will work on the finesse fundamentals of Senior training with focus on the techniques of teaching sequence and progression and the individual drills & skills used in the Senior Program in accordance with the NSP Transportation Manual & the Senior OET Program.

9:00am – 2:00pm - Ski Trainer's Workshop (STW)**NSP Course # P05.....**

This course is for all S&T Instructors, Evaluators and Mentors. This clinic is taught by a PSIA Level 3 Instructors and will improve skiing evaluation skills of NSP Transportation Program instructors, providing NSP trainers a means to develop a photographic eye using observational cues to assist them in training toboggan operators. The course will also give the Instructors the tools to correct the techniques of the Alpine patrollers.

12:00pm – 2:00pm - Above Palmer and Beyond – Tour & Training – Back Country Techniques (TES)**NSP Course # P05.....**

This clinic will be conducted by S&T Instructors who are Avy/MTR and seasoned mountaineers that will lead a tour to the Hogs back and Illumination Rock on Mt Hood to explore out of bounds terrain above the Palmer lift, providing insight into techniques for toboggan rescue outside the resort boundaries. **You will need to have your own transceiver, shovel, probe, skins and/or snowshoes to participate. The class will require skiing/boarding from out of bounds back into the resort at the end of the class. Actual location will be weather and terrain dependent. You will need to fill out a wilderness permit (located in the day lodge) prior to the leaving the permitted ski area boundary.**

The course objective is to train using multiple sled types in the backcountry, and a review of belay techniques.

NATIONAL SKI PATROL SYSTEM EVENT/TRAINING RELEASE FORM

I agree I am voluntarily participating in this EVENT/TRAINING. I understand that the EVENT/TRAINING may involve extensive field work on first aid scenarios, skiing, and toboggan handling along with other activities which ski patrollers encounter in their duties of patrolling a ski area. I realize there are inherent risks in this type of activity including changing weather conditions, changing snow surface conditions, ice, bare spots, rocks, stumps, trees and the possibility of collisions with manmade and natural objects or other skiers and such activity can be dangerous and can result in serious injury or death. I knowingly assume the risk of participation and understand I can withdraw from this EVENT/TRAINING at any time. I understand that by participating in this EVENT/TRAINING I may also encounter additional risks not inherent to a normal participant to the sport of skiing. I agree to personally assume all of these risks. I also agree that I will rely solely on my own judgment regarding my personal safety and ability with regard to the terrain, circumstances and conditions in which I may be placed upon and asked to demonstrate or perform to accomplish the tasks involved in EVENT/TRAINING, and that I will decline to perform any activities if I believe I am placing myself in an unsafe situation or subject to possible injury or death if I proceeded.
